

## 2016-2017 NCPA Jersey Requirements

### 1. Production Standards

- a. All jerseys bearing the NCPA Logo must adhere to all requirements as listed in Agreement.
  - i. Adjustments to requirements may be made by NCPA through the season. Those adjustments will be sent in written form to all manufacturers, as well as listed on the NCPA website in the Jersey Information Section, <http://ncpapaintball.com/info/jersey-requirements/>.
- b. No jersey bearing the NCPA Logo may be produced by a manufacturer prior to approval of the entire, final jersey design by the NCPA. All jersey design proofs must be submitted to NCPA for approval at least 2 business days before production. Once approved, the design should not be modified in any way, other than changing the name and number listed on the jersey for each individual player.

### 2. Production Requirements

#### a. No Padding

- i. Padding in jerseys is strictly prohibited.
  1. Padding is defined as any area of a garment that exceeds the thickness of two standard 100% cotton T-Shirts.
  2. Quilting is defined as any area of the garment not considered padding that exceeds the thickness of one standard 100% cotton T-Shirt.
  3. Any area of a garment with quilting counts as two layers.
  4. Quilting may not be combined in the same area with other padding worn by the player under any circumstances. This means any quilting in the lower arm area will prevent a player from wearing arm pads with the jersey.
- ii. A single, padded, half or full glove may be affixed to the wrist area of each arm of the jersey. Note that glove padding may not overlap padding of any arm pad worn by the player.

#### b. Numbers

- i. All player numbers must be one or two digits only. Each digit must be an integer greater than or equal to 0 and less than or equal to 9.
- ii. Player number is required in three locations on all jerseys.
  1. Back
    - a. Player number shall be centered on the back of the jersey.
    - b. Player number shall be at least 8 inches high.
    - c. Player number shall be no more than 2" below the player's last name
  2. Top of Shoulder – Left and Right
    - a. The top of the player number may be no further than 3 inches from the inside of the collar of the jersey.
    - b. Player number shall straddle the center line of the top of the shoulder, drawn from the neck to the arm. The top edge of the numbers should face towards the neck, and the bottom edge of the numbers should face towards the arm.
      - i. As a clarification, on raglan cut jerseys, the player number must appear at the top of the sleeve with the top edge facing the collar. On inset cut jerseys, the player number should straddle the shoulder seams between the back and front pieces of the jersey.
    - c. Shoulder player numbers must be at least 3.5 inches tall.

#### c. Shoulders – Reserved area

- i. No logo shall be placed between the shoulder player number and the collar of the jersey.

- d. Upper Back – Reserved Area
  - i. No logo shall be placed between the top of the player’s last name and the collar of the jersey.
- e. NCPA Logo
  - i. The NCPA Logo must be placed at the top of each arm. It must appear immediately below the shoulder player number, with no other logo between the player number and the NCPA Logo.
  - ii. NCPA Logo may not be altered in any way, except size, from its original form, including, but not limited to, color and proportion.
  - iii. The NCPA Logo must be at least 4.5” in diameter on the jersey.
- f. Player Name
  - i. Player’s last name is required. Limited exceptions on a per-school basis may be granted by NCPA at its sole discretion, and will be provided in written communication to Manufacturer.
    - 1. Last name shall appear on the back top center of the jersey
    - 2. Last name shall be at least 3 inches tall.
  - ii. Player’s first name or initial is optional.
    - 1. First name may appear in any size
- g. School Logo
  - i. The team’s logo shall appear centered on the front of the jersey, with the top of the logo no further than 4” from the edge of a standard crew-neck collar at the vertical midline of the jersey front.
  - ii. Minimum team logo size is 8 inches tall and 12 inches wide.
- h. Colors and Theme
  - i. Jersey should appear in color scheme of official school colors for each University.
- i. Sponsor logo(s)
  - i. Sponsor logos may appear on the jersey in the following locations:
    - 1. No more than 50.00 square inches of area above the school logo on the front of the jersey. Area shall be measured by computing the total area of a rectangle whose borders consist of horizontal lines tangent to each of the highest and lowest points of the logo, and vertical lines tangent to the leftmost and rightmost points of the logo.
    - 2. Unlimited sponsor logos may appear below the player number on the back of the jersey. Logos shall appear a minimum of 2 inches below the bottom edge of the back player number.
    - 3. An unlimited number of sponsor logos may appear on the sleeves a minimum of 2 inches below NCPA logos.
    - 4. The jersey manufacturer may place a logo on the collar of the jersey, where the collar is a separate piece of fabric completely encircling the neck of the jersey, and the collar is no more than 1.5 inches wide.
